Section 1 : Enhanced Safety Measures on Dump Truck Operation (Use of AI Network Cameras) in Large-scaled Infrastructure Project in Hong

Kong

In considering the repetitive operations for the dump truck to tipping soil materials (in close proximity to the slope edge) and the potential hazard where the truck may fall down from the slope: a system has to be developed for alerting the truck driver as well as the site supervisory personnel. The proposed system should be able to instantly pushing an alert to the truck driver and at the same time giving a signal to the nearby supervising personnel WHILE equipped with a real time monitoring with video recording the actual site situation. The network AI cameras detection system will be proposed.
